#### **USAGE GUIDE**

Do not use in wet or damp conditions

- 1. Once the Block Paving has been laid use directly from the bag and brush into block paving with a wide soft brush.
- Ideally, make two or three passes with a mechanical plate vibrator. The Sand should be constantly brushed under the leading edge of the vibrator so that it is placed down between the blocks.
